Ergon Energy NQ Junior Age Championships- Day 2

Another perfect morning in Townsville to start off day 2 of the NQ Junior Age Championships, currently being played at Tennis Townsville!

The Championships started Sunday 25 September and will finish tomorrow, Tuesday 27 September. The event includes age groups starting from 10U to 18U.

In the 10U Girls Singles, 8 year old Mikayla Zahirovic (Tennis Townsville) won the finals match against Helena Fricke (Mount Isa) receiving the Champion title for the 10U Girls Singles.

In the 12U Boys Singles, number 1 seed Adam Walton (Home Hill) defeated Ashley Wilson from Mackay in the Semi Finals snatching himself a spot in the Finals. Adam will be playing number 2 seed, Thomas Braithwaite (Mount Isa) in the Final tomorrow (Tuesday) morning at 8.00am

In the 12U Girls Singles, the top 2 seeds will play each other in the Finals at 8.45am tomorrow morning. Number 1 seed, Alix Leckenby (Brandon) will play number 2 seed, Lily Clements-Markham (Cairns).

In the 14U Boys Singles, Ryan Schwab (Townsville) defeated number 1 seed Jack Walton for a spot in the Finals. Schwab will play number 2 seed, Brendan Goldsmith (Cairns) tomorrow morning at 8.00am. Brittany Zipf (Rockhampton), the number 1 seed in the 14U Girls Singles cruised into the Finals winning the Semi Final 6-0, 6-1 against Tenika McGiffin (Mackay). Brittany will play Samantha Nyika (Mackay), the number 2 seed in the Finals.

The 14U Girls Doubles were held this afternoon which saw Majella Nobile (Tennis Townsville) and Lisa Payne (Townsville) play an exciting match against Tenika McGiffin (Mackay) and Samantha Nyika (Mackay). The Townsville girls proved too good for the Mackay girls and won the Finals.

In the 16U Girls Singles, the number 1 seed Jelena Stefanovic (NSW) was a no show in the Quarter Finals which means Georgia Inwood (Mount Isa) cruised through to the semi finals where she played Tennis Townsville local, Majella Nobile. Majella defeated Georgia Inwood 6-0, 6-0 which makes her very deserving of her spot in the Finals. She'll be playing Ashlee Priddey from Cairns tomorrow morning at 8.00am

Seth Siriya, Tennis Townsville local and number 1 seed in the 16U Boys Singles defeated Tyson Daly (Proserpine) 6-4, 6-3 in the Semi Finals. It was a very close game and both boys gave it their best. The number 2 seed, Norbert Kaess (Tennis Townsville) did not get a spot in the Final, with Mitchell Robins (Brisbane) defeating him 6-0, 6-3. Mitchell defeated the number 3 seed, Rhan Burton (Cairns) in the Quarter Finals, the number 2 seed Norbert Kaess (Tennis Townsville) in the Semi Final. How will he go up against the number 1 seed, Seth Siriya (Tennis Townsville) in the Finals? They'll be playing for the top spot tomorrow morning at 8.00am

Rhan Burton from Cairns, the number 1 seed in the 18U Boys Singles took on Mitchell Robins (Brisbane) in the Finals this afternoon. Mitchell and Rhan both played an amazing match, but the winner of this event was Mitchell defeating Rhan 6-1, 6-0.

With the Finals being held tomorrow morning, Tennis Townsville can only wonder what these juniors have in store! The talent has been amazing so far, and we know they'll be playing their best tennis at the Finals tomorrow!
